Section 6, subsection 18 of the CSPOA Declaration of Restrictions states the following:

"No sign (including but not limited to "For Sale" or similar signs), billboards or other advertising structure of any kind may be erected or maintained upon any Lot except after applying to and receiving written permission from the Association."

Signs on improved lots shall be no larger than 24 inches by 24 inches, and on a freestanding support. No more than two (2) signs in total may be placed on any lot; for example, one in the front and one in the rear. On corner lots a V-shaped sign may be used, and considered to be one sign. No signs are allowed on any unimproved lot.
