TENNIS COURT RULES & REGULATIONS

The CSPOA Tennis Courts shall be available and used exclusively for the enjoyment of all CSPOA members, their immediate families, and their guests, in conformance with the following conditions.

1. To use the tennis courts you must be a member in good standing of the CSPOA or a qualified guest of a member in good standing.
2. Members in good standing may invite guests with the following limitations: The number of guests per member (who do not qualify as house guests) shall not exceed three (3) adults and their minor children on any one occasion and those guests may use the tennis courts no more than two times within a month. House guests are exempt from these limitations, provided they have come more than 50 miles in order to visit a member of the CSPOA.
3. Children under age 13 must be accompanied by a supervising adult.
4. The courts are kept locked. CSPOA members in good standing can obtain a key from the CSPOA office (during normal business hours) for a small fee.
5. The tennis courts are reserved for Open Tennis every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday 9 a.m. – 11 a.m. (winter months) and 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. (summer months). Open Tennis is open to all members and their guests who show up to play. Except for Open Tennis, court time shall be limited to one hour for singles and 1-1/2 hours for doubles when all four courts are in use and players are waiting for a court.
6. No tennis after 10 p.m. Turn off the lights when leaving the courts at night.
7. Only persons in proper attire are permitted to use the courts. Men must wear shirts at all times. Cut-off shorts are permitted, but bathing suits or any other attire not considered appropriate are prohibited. Players must wear TENNIS SHOES ONLY.
8. No pets on the courts. No skating, skateboarding, or bikes are allowed on the courts.
9. No bottles or glass items are allowed on the courts. Trash should be placed in the containers provided. **No smoking on the tennis courts.**
10. Sweeping, squeegee, and blower equipment is available in the Tennis Equipment Storage Shed, located alongside the courts. All equipment must be returned to the storage shed after use and the doors locked. The key to the tennis courts also opens the storage shed.
11. Players are responsible for maintaining and restoring the tennis courts to a neat and orderly condition before leaving. Gates must be locked when departing an empty court.
