As we stated in last month's article, we are in the process of inspecting vacant lots that are due for bush hogging/cleaning. If your unimproved lot needs this work done, you will receive a letter from the ACC. Please respond to the ACC within the time frame specified in the letter. If needed, the ACC has a list of qualified, insured contractors who can do the job. Please call or e-mail the ACC for this information.
