#### ACC Corner – Joe Rochel, ACC Chairperson

Hello again. Just a note for all the new homeowners in the Carolina Shores community. Welcome and I trust the following information will be helpful.

The ACC (Architectural Control Committee) oversees the issuing of permits for new homes being built and improvements to existing homes. The ACC Chairman manages a group of volunteers to accomplish this task and reports to the Carolina Shores Board of Directors every month. All exterior changes such as painting (even if it's the same color), additions, new roofs, driveways, shutters, storm doors, fencing, and tree removal are a few examples of needing a permit from the CSPOA ACC office. Our Declaration of Restrictions is the legal document that gives the POA authority. If you are a new resident, both your realtor and attorney are required by law to disclose these restrictions.

Violations that we are experiencing at this time are no roof permits, no fencing permits, painting without a permit, and unkept yards. Also, please note that utility trailers are to be stored in a garage and cannot be stored anywhere else on your property. Please help us with these items. If you have any ACC questions, please call the office at 910-579-2044. **COMMUNICATION IS THE KEY TO AVOIDING FURTHER ACTION AND FINES WHEN THE FIRST LETTER IS RECEIVED.** 

I would like to remind all Carolina Shores' homeowners that June is the start of the HURRICANE season and continues to the end of November. I recommend you look up information for preparedness on the Carolina Shores Town website <u>www.carolinashoresnc.com</u> or call the town at 910-575-4877 and sign up to receive their emails about bad weather and other information.

You can receive emergency information from the town by signing up to be on their email list. While on the town's home page, scroll down to the last line under Announcements. Click on Connect with Us! and enter your information. You can also get county information by clicking on the Code Red symbol towards the bottom of the town's home page. If you need help with any of this, please call the town.

A note to all residents that want to report an infraction against the Declaration of Restrictions or the Rules & Regulations. **NO ACTION** will be taken by the ACC office without the complainant giving their name on the "Request for Inspection" form or over the phone when they call or leave a voicemail message. Complainants' information is strictly confidential and will not be given to anyone requesting it. Only office staff are privileged to this information.
